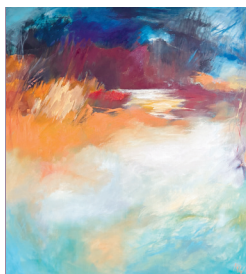


Ingegerd K Westin

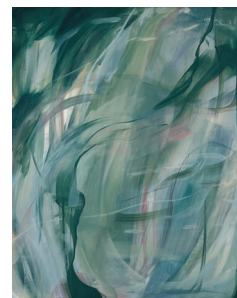
